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GUIDE FOR THE APPLICATION OF THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MONBUKAGAKUSHO) SCHOLARSHIP FOR FOREIGN POSTGRADUATE MASTER COURSE STUDENTS

The Nagasaki University Priority Graduate Programs (NUPGP) is a special course in the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, Nagasaki University, started in October 2007. The NUPGP provides opportunities for qualified graduates from overseas to study on Biological and Medicinal Sciences of infectious diseases, pain, drug addiction, environmental pollutants, anticancer target molecules and medicinal natural products.

The objectives of the NUPGP are to produce competent persons in frontier of those fields as well as impact knowledge of national policy planning in those fields when students go back to their mother countries.

To efficiently meet the goals of the NUPGP, intensive training of a wide scope is provided to students by Professors of Pharmaceutical Sciences in the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. Lectures and Instructions of NUPGP are given in English.

This is a call for application to a two-year Master Course for the academic year of 2012 sponsored by the Scholarship Program of Monbukagakusho (The Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japanese Government).

For deciding the field and the topic of research, applicants choose the appropriate supervisor(s) appearing on the List of Academic Staffs.

Qualifications

- 1. Nationality: Non-Japanese citizens from foreign countries can apply for the program.
- 2. Academic carrier: The following candidates may apply for admission.
 - a. Those who have Bachelor's Degree from Japanese University as of September 30, 2012.
 - b. Those who have a Degree equivalent, to Bachelor's Degree of Japanese Universities as of September 30, 2012.
 - c. Those who have been designated by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology of Japanese Government.
 - d. Those who are 22 years old or more as of September 30, 2012, and less than 35 years old as of April 1, 2012 (Date of birth is after April 2, 1977), and are admitted as that their academic abilities are equivalent to or higher than Bachelor's Degree of Japanese Universities upon reviewing the submitted materials.
- 3. Health: Applicants should be in good health both mentally and physically.
- 4. Language proficiency: A good working level of English is required.
- 5. Arrival in Japan: Applicants should arrive in Japan on the designated period, if admitted.

Remarks

- 1) Military personnel and civilian employees of the armed forces are not eligible.
- 2) Admission shall be canceled if the applicant fails to arrive in Japan on the designated period.
- 3) Admission shall be canceled if the applicant fails to receive the Bachelor's Degree on or before September 30, 2012.
- 4) Applicants, who will receive scholarship money from an institution (including government institutions of the student's country of origin) other than the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho), shall not be eligible for the scholarship.
- 5) Applicants, who is applying to other Japanese university, shall not be eligible for the scholarship. Applicants, who are applying for the other Japanese government scholarship and the Japan Student Services Organization scholarship, shall not be eligible for the scholarship. Applicants can not apply for any other scholarship, coincidentally.
- 6) Admission shall be canceled if the applicant lives in Japan before starting NUPGP.

The scholarship includes the followings.

- 1. Amount of scholarship
 - A student will receive a monthly scholarship of 152,000 yen. (This amount may change.)
- 2. Travel expenses
 - Travel to Japan
 - Travel expenses will be paid, in the form of economy class air tickets, from the international

airport nearest to the student's city of residence in their country to one of the international airports nearest to Nagasaki University.

Travel from Japan

Upon completing the scholarship tenure and returning to their country by the designated date, travel expenses will be paid, in the form of economy class air tickets, from one of the international airports nearest to Nagasaki University to the international airport nearest to their city of residence in their country.

3. Scholarship tenure

For 2 years, from October, 2012 to September, 2014.

Enrollment and Tuition expenses

- 1. Monbukagakusho scholarship recipients are exempted from entrance examination fee and entrance fee and tuition fee.
- 2. Date of enrollment: October 1, 2012.

Selection and Admission

- 1. The applicants should be a degree holder of higher grade (preferably A grade or First class honors) in her/his field. Official documents to certify this should be attached together with the application forms (see Application 1.-②). Only those who have a solid academic background, research capability and commitment are selected. The final decision of Monbukagakusho scholarship will be informed to the candidates through Nagasaki University at the end of June, 2012.
